

GUIDELINES FOR LOCAL BOATOWNERS

West side of walk-ashore pontoons

Applies to the west side of the pontoon link ups only.

Up to 9 hours free of charge.

Between 9 and 24 hours, 50% reduction.

There is a requirement to check in with the marina office prior to using this facility.

Layover and pick-up/drop-off points available to local boat owners

Cambridge and Crown Pier steps. Quick drop offs and pick-ups only.

Boats should not be left unattended at these points; they are for the safe and quick transfer of people and not for any other use.

Local layby pontoon

Short stays of up to 12 hours.

Victoria Marina & Swan pontoons

Longer stays of between 24 and 72 hours.

Visitor rates apply.

The Cruise liner pontoon at the end of the Albert Pier is designated as a temporary secure area during cruise liner operations. On other days, local vessels may use the pontoon for quick drop offs and pick-ups only, with prior permission from the Marina Office or Port Control. Boats should not be left unattended at these points; they are for the safe and quick transfer of people and not for any other use. Unattended vessels may be removed.

From time-to-time, especially during July and August, capacity may be at its maximum in all the areas of St. Peter Port harbours. During these times, the Marina Staff will advise local customers if the use of berths is temporarily unavailable.
