



## Local Notices to Mariners

<b>LNTM No.</b>	046/2021
<b>Subject</b>	<b>COVID 19 – Locally Registered Leisure Vessels Returning from Outside of the Bailiwick</b>

- All arrivals into the Bailiwick must be registered on the Travel Tracker and enter your journey within 8 days prior to arrival into the Bailiwick. [Welcome to the Travel Tracker | Guernsey Travel Tracker \(gov.gg\)](#)
- On arrival into the Bailiwick proceed to St Peter Port contacting Victoria Marina on VHF Ch.80 for further instructions and to confirm your Travel Tracker status.
- The Bailiwick of Guernsey accepts valid vaccination certification of an approved vaccine (AstraZeneca, Pfizer, Moderna and Janssen) from all international jurisdictions.

***CTA - Common Travel Area: United Kingdom, the Bailiwick of Guernsey, the Bailiwick of Jersey, the Isle of Man and the Republic of Ireland.***

**Fully vaccinated** – Traveller can provide the necessary proof they have received a full course of an approved vaccine (AstraZeneca, Pfizer, Moderna and Janssen) and 14 days have passed since their last dose.

### **Travel within the Common Travel Area (CTA) - Blue Channel**

All travel from the CTA regardless of vaccination status will be treated as 'blue'. This means:

- Purchase pack of 5 Lateral flow tests (LFTs) for travellers aged 12 and over.
- Travellers aged 5 - 11 years will be provided with a pack of 5 LFTs free of charge.
- **It is a legal requirement\*** to undertake an LFT on the day of your arrival and then an LFT on days 3, 5, 7 and 9 after your arrival.
- No isolation.

## **Travel from outside of the Common Travel Area (CTA)**

**All travel from outside of the CTA within the last 10 days will be required to:**

### **For vaccinated travellers - from rest of the world**

- Day 1 test for travellers aged 12 and over.
- Isolate until Day 1 negative result.
- Children aged 5 - 11 years will be provided with 5 LFTs free of charge. Children under the age of 11 must be registered on the Travel Tracker account of **one** travelling adult only.
- **It is a legal requirement\*** to undertake an LFT on the day of your arrival and then an LFT on days 3, 5, 7 and 9 after your arrival.
- For unvaccinated children aged 12-17. The parent's vaccine information can be added to the child's travel tracker account, so they can benefit from this vaccinated status.
- 12 - 17 year olds with one dose of vaccine plus 14 days since dose are considered fully vaccinated.

### **For unvaccinated travellers - from rest of the world**

- Day 1 and Day 8 tests for travellers aged 12 and over.
- Isolate until Day 8 negative result.
- Children aged 5-11 will not be PCR tested, instead will be provided with 5 LFTs free of charge. They follow the same self-isolation requirements as accompanying parents/guardians. Children under the age of 11 must be registered on the Travel Tracker account of **one** travelling adult only.
- **It is a legal requirement\*** to undertake an LFT on the day of your arrival and then an LFT on days 3, 5, 7 and 9 after your arrival.
- Unvaccinated children aged 12-17 will be tested and follow the same self-isolation requirements as accompanying parents/guardians. If the parents are vaccinated the parents vaccine details can be added to the child's travel tracker account, so the child can benefit from this vaccinated status. (See **vaccinated travellers above**)
- 12 - 17 year olds with one dose of vaccine plus 14 days since dose are considered fully vaccinated.
- If you decline to take a test, you must self-isolate for 10 days.

### **For all travellers, vaccinated and unvaccinated, travelling directly into the Bailiwick from a region on the UKs red list**

- Day 1 and Day 9 PCR tests for travellers aged 12 and over.
- Isolate until Day 9 negative result.
- Children aged 5-11 will not be PCR tested, instead will be provided with 5 LFTs free of charge. They follow the same self-isolation requirements as accompanying parents/guardians. Children under the age of 11 must be registered on the Travel Tracker account of **one** travelling adult only.

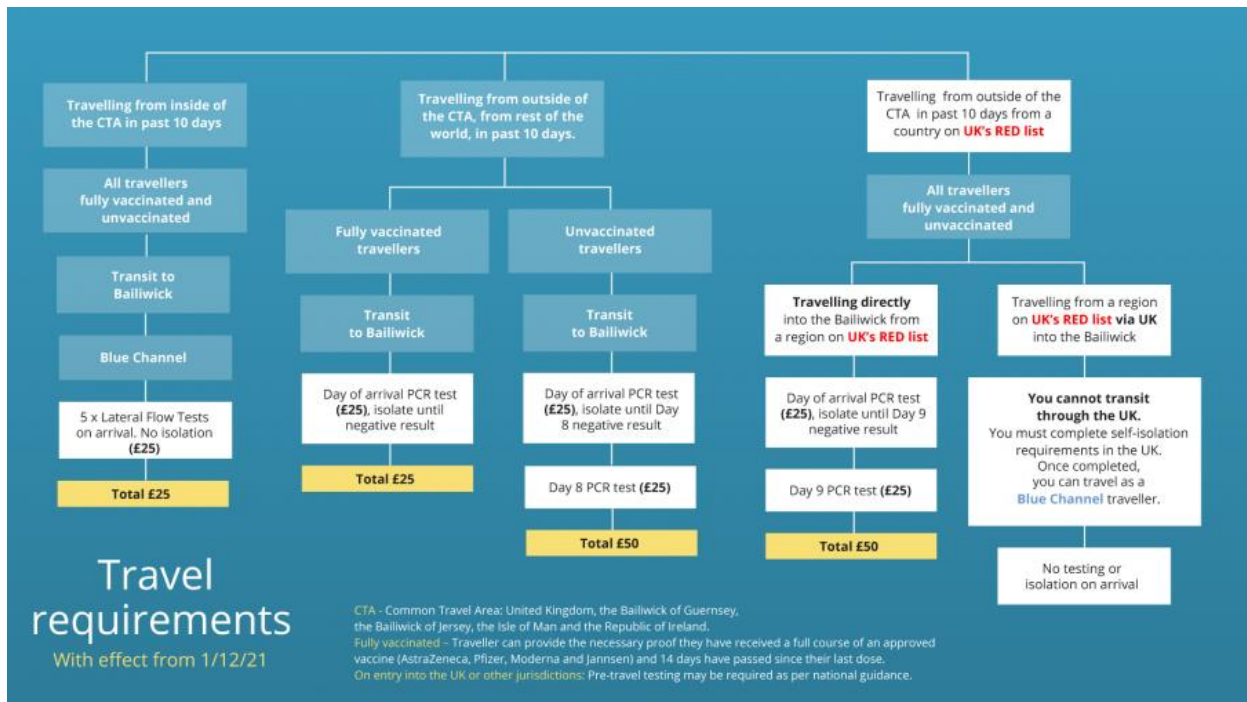

- If you decline to take a test, you must self-isolate for 10 days.

**For all travellers, vaccinated and unvaccinated, travelling from a region on the UK's red list via the UK into the Bailiwick**

- You cannot transit through the UK. You must complete self-isolation requirements in the UK.
- Once completed, you can travel as a Blue Channel traveller. (See Blue Channel above).
