

# TAKE CARE OF YOUR FLARE

Flares and gas canisters are highly explosive even when they're expired or empty.

Our black bag waste is processed using specialist machinery. If flares or gas canisters find their way into this, they can explode and damage the equipment. This can be dangerous to our staff and the environment, too.

**Dunking flares in water isn't enough to make them safe**



**Lighting flares or emptying canisters isn't enough to make them safe**

## NOT IN THE BIN. HAND THEM IN

There are lots of options to safely dispose of flares and gas canisters. All are free of charge.

### **GAS CANISTERS:**

Take them to the Longue Hougue Household Waste and Recycling Centre free of charge. Guernsey Gas will collect their own canisters.

### **FLARES:**

Hand them in to, AB Marine Ltd at White Rock or The Guernsey Police Station
